Springfield Centre provides high-quality day and community support for older adults with intellectual disabilities who require higher levels of care.

Our service has been running at near-full capacity since opening in 2021, and for the first time, we are now welcoming new referrals.

We specialise in supporting participants who have:

- Higher physical support needs
- Complex care requirements
- A preference for a safe, purpose-built environment with professional staff



Built-In Accessibility Features

Springfield is designed to provide comfort, safety, and dignity for participants with higher needs, featuring:

- Extra-wide hallways for mobility support
- · Wave-to-open automatic doors
- Sensory room and quiet spaces
- Accessible community activity spaces

Unlike fixed-schedule services, our approach at our Springfield Centre is responsive to how participants are feeling on the day. We focus on wellbeing, and each person is supported to choose how they want to spend their time, with freedom to follow their own pace and preferences.

For the first time since Springfield Centre opened in 2021, we are able to offer new placements.

Our Support Services

All support is delivered by our qualified and experienced Alkira staff. Every team member is employed and trained by Alkira, which means the people and families we support see familiar faces and build trusted relationships. Around 75% of our staff are permanent — either full-time or part-time — which supports consistency and strong connections. Staff turnover is low, with many team members staying for over 10 years, and our longest-serving staff member

having been with Alkira for more than 28 years. This continuity helps create a reliable, supportive environment for the people we support.

Our Springfield centre team is trained in manual handling, personal care, and use of hoists and mobility equipment, ensuring safe and consistent care.




Referral Pathway


Referrals are welcome for older adults with intellectual disabilities with NDIS funding.
